# STUDENT CHECKLIST

### 1. APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Admission to SPC is based on an open-door philosophy. To be eligible for admission to SPC, you must have a diploma from an accredited high school or successfully completed the General Education Development test. Students seeking admission to SPC should complete the following steps:

#### 2. TAKE A PLACEMENT TEST

VACCINATION (IF UNDER AGE 22)

Students enrolling in college level courses should take a placement test before registering for classes. South Plains College offers the approved statewide exam called the TSI Assessment. Scores from the TSI Assessment are used for advisement and placement of students in appropriate coursework.

# I MAY BE EXEMPT FROM TAKING A PLACEMENT TEST A student could be exempt from taking a placement test if he/she scores well enough on the ACT or SAT tests.
